ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF CORPORATE NAME AND APPROVING ADOPTION NOTICE

Unidial Communications, Inc. (Unidial), a Kentucky corporation, submitted an adoption notice on March 31, 1998, designed to reflect its change of corporate name from "Unidial Incorporated." The company was certificated to provide interexchange telecommunications services on January 26, 1994, in Case No. TA-94-141. Unidial included with its filing an Amended Certificate of Authority from the Missouri Secretary of State reflecting its new corporate name. Unidial's adoption notice carries an effective date of April 30, 1998. The company filed a substitute sheet to correct a typographical error on April 3.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum on April 21 stating that it had reviewed the company's filing and adoption notice and had no objection to their approval. Staff recommended that the name change be recognized and the adoption notice approved to become effective on April 30.

The Commission has reviewed Unidial's filing, the adoption notice, and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the change of name should be

recognized. The Commission further finds that the adoption notice reflecting that change of name should be approved as amended.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the change of corporate name from "Unidial Incorporated" to "Unidial Communications, Inc." is acknowledged.
- 2. That the adoption notice denominated P.S.C. Mo. No. 1, Original Adoption Notice Page 1 is approved as amended to become effective on April 30, 1998.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on April 30, 1998.
