REQUEST FOR MEMORANDUM ON STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

On October 2, 1998, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a complaint against House Springs Sewer Company (House Springs) for failure to pay its Commission-ordered assessments. House Springs filed an answer on December 21, 1998. As a result of discussions, the Staff, Office of the Public Counsel, and House Springs filed their proposed Stipulation and Agreement (Agreement) on May 10, 1999.

The Agreement stated that, if requested by the Commission, the Staff shall have the right to submit to the Commission a memorandum explaining its rationale for entering into the Agreement. Each party shall be served with a copy of the memorandum and shall have the right to submit to the Commission a responsive memorandum served on all parties. The responsive memorandum shall be served on all parties within five (5) business days of the service of the Staff's memorandum.

Thus, the Commission will request a memorandum from the Staff as set forth above to be filed within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this request.

The Commission had ordered on May 4, 1999, that the filing of the procedural schedule should be stayed until June 4, 1999. Due to the developments in this case, the Commission will order that the filing of the procedural schedule be stayed until August 2, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Public Service Commission shall furnish a memorandum explaining its rationale for entering into the proposed Stipulation and Agreement between the parties, filed on May 10, 1999, the said memorandum to be filed within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this request.

2. That the parties shall be given until August 2, 1999, to file a procedural schedule.

3. That this order shall become effective on June 7, 1999.
