RESPONSE AND OBJECTIONS OF APPLICANT SOUTHERN UNION COMPANY TO APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

Comes now Southern Union Company ("Southern Union") d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy, by and through counsel, and provides its response and objections to certain applications to intervene filed in this proceeding:

- 1. Pursuant to the Commission's January 16th Order Providing Notice, Establishing Time for Intervention, Scheduling a Prehearing Conference and Relieving Staff and Other Parties of the Obligation to File a Recommendation by February 3, 2003, Applications to Intervene in the captioned proceeding have been filed by Enbridge Pipelines ("Enbridge"), the Attorney General of the State of Missouri (the "Attorney General"), Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE ("AmerenUE"), Local 5-348 of Paper, Allied-Industrial, Chemical and Energy International Union ("PACE"), Midwest Gas Users Association ("Midwest"), Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede") and Municipal Gas Commission of Missouri ("MGCM").
- 2. Southern Union objects to the intervention of PACE in the captioned proceeding. Counsel for PACE did not appear at the scheduled prehearing conference on

Tuesday, January 28, 2003 and, to the knowledge of Southern Union, was not excused from appearing at the prehearing conference. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(3) provides that a party may be dismissed from a case for failure to appear. Southern Union suggests that failure to appear is likewise grounds for denial of an Application to Intervene. Furthermore, Local 5-348 of PACE does not represent any employees of Missouri Gas Energy.

- 3. Southern Union does not object to intervention by the Attorney General. This does not constitute a waiver of Southern Union's position that the matters which are addressed in Missouri's Antitrust Law (Chapter 416 RSMo) are issues that are not properly before the Commission. Rather, such issues appear to reside exclusively within the authority of the Office of the Attorney General.
- 4. Southern Union does not object to the intervention of Enbridge, AmerenUE, Midwest, Laclede or MGCM. However, Southern Union reserves the right to contend that certain issues that may be raised by said parties are not relevant to the matter at hand or are not within the area of the Commission's subject matter jurisdiction over the proposed transaction.

WHEREFORE, Southern Union objects to the intervention of PACE and does not object to the intervention of Enbridge, the Attorney General, AmerenUE, Midwest, Laclede or MGCM for the reasons aforesaid.
