## **ORDER SCHEDULING HEARING**

Missouri Gas Energy, the Commission Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel filed a Stipulation and Agreement Regarding True-Up Audit and Hearing on April 10, 1998. The agreement purports to resolve the issues of the time period for which a true-up audit will be conducted and the items to be addressed in the true-up audit. The agreement also proposes dates for the filing of true-up testimony and for a true-up hearing. Midwest Gas Users Association and Jackson County, et al. filed a Joint Objection to Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.115(3) on April 17. These intervenors object to the stipulation's specification of items to be included in the true-up audit and request a hearing on the matter. They also state that they did not receive a copy of the stipulation until April 13 which is relevant because 4 CSR 240-2.115(3) allows parties only five days from receipt of notice of a stipulation to file a request for hearing.

The Commission finds that a hearing should be conducted to consider the objections raised to the true-up stipulation. Because this case is set for an evidentiary hearing in May, and because of the exigencies of the Commission's hearing schedule, the public necessity requires that this RS CE W limited hearing be held on less than ten days notice as permitted by 4 CSR 240-2.110(2). The Commission will conduct a hearing on Tuesday, April 28 at 10:00 a.m. to consider the objections raised to the Stipulation and Agreement filed on April 10.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Commission will conduct a hearing on Tuesday, April 28, at 10:00 a.m. to consider the objections raised to the Stipulation and Agreement Regarding True-Up Audit and Hearing filed on April 10, 1998. The hearing will be held in the Commission's hearing room on the fifth floor of the Harry S Truman State Office Building, 301 West High Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.
