**ORDER DIRECTING STATUS REPORT**

On June 18, 1998, the Commission issued an Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement. Pursuant to the stipulation, Warren County Water & Sewer Company (WCWS) was to erect and place into service an elevated water storage tank. The Commission will direct its Staff to report on the status of the tank, and to make a recommendation as to whether this case may be closed.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Staff of the Commission shall file a report on the status of Warren County Water & Sewer Company's elevated water storage tank no later than September 7, 1999, and include a recommendation as to whether this case may be closed.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 30, 1999.
