On June 19, 1997, Shawnee Bend Water and Sewer L.L.C. (Shawnee Bend) filed an application with the Commission requesting a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide both water and sewer service to the public in an unincorporated area of Camden County, Missouri. In that application, Shawnee Bend stated that the proposed service area is currently uninhabited but added that Four Seasons Lakesites Water & Sewer Company (Four Seasons) also has an interest in serving the proposed area.

On August 21, an applicant referring to itself as "Four Seasons" filed an Application to Intervene in this proceeding, citing rights obtained from the Commission to provide service to this area. No objections to that intervention were tendered.

A certificate was granted for all or part of the proposed service area by this Commission to Four Seasons Lakesites Water & Sewer Company in Case No. WA-95-164. Therefore, Four Seasons Lakesites Water & Sewer Company has an interest in this proceeding different from that of the general public. However, nowhere in this application does it state that the applicant "Four Seasons" is the same legal entity as Four Seasons

Lakesites Water & Sewer Company, the legal holder of the certificate. Therefore, the Commission will allow the applicant in this case 10 days in which to amend its application to clarify the corporate relationship between Four Seasons Lakesites Water & Sewer Company and "Four Seasons."

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the applicant has 10 days from the effective date of this order in which to amend its application as stated above.
- 2. That this order shall become effective on September 9, 1997.
