## ORDER APPROVING ADOPTION NOTICES FILED IN COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER APPROVING MERGER

On November 26, 1997, the Commission issued an Order Approving a Merger of Ascension Resorts, Ltd. (Ascension) and Silverleaf Resorts, Inc. (Silverleaf) with Silverleaf being the surviving entity. That order required Silverleaf to adopt Ascension's tariff for Missouri operations.

On December 2 Silverleaf filed an Adoption Notice and revised index sheet to effect the adoption by Silverleaf of all tariffs, schedules, rules, notices or other instruments filed with this Commission by Ascension for the provision of sewer and water service. Silverleaf proposes that said adoption of Ascension's tariff become effective December 12.

On December 9 the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum to the official case file. Staff states that the Adoption Notices and revised indexes are correct and comply with the Commission's order. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the proposed tariff sheets to become effective on and after December 12.

Based on the proposed tariff sheets and the Staff's memorandum, the Commission determines that the tariff sheets comply with the Commission's Order Approving Merger and that they should be approved.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

 That the following tariff sheets are approved for sewer service to be provided by Silverleaf Resorts, Inc. on and after December 12, 1997.
