ORDER RESETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On April 3, 1997, UtiliCorp United Inc. (UtiliCorp) filed an application with the Commission requesting authorization to sell an approximate five mile long, 12-inch in diameter natural gas transmission pipeline to Williams Natural Gas Company. On August 8, 1997, the Commission issued its order suspending the procedural schedule in this matter at the request of the Staff of the Commission. The Commission asked the parties to advise the Commission as to the disposition of this matter no later than September 5, 1997.

On August 28, 1997, the Staff filed a motion for a revised procedural schedule for the litigation of this case. No objections to the Staff motion were filed. The Staff proposed the following schedule:

The Commission finds the proposed schedule to be reasonable and will adopt it for use in this proceeding. The Commission also advises the parties that, due to the extremely large case load and trial schedule currently before the Commission, the transcript of the evidentiary hearing will be expedited and the briefing schedule will consist of only one round of simultaneous briefs, limited to 35 pages apiece.
