ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

LCI International Telecom Corp. (LCI) submitted a tariff filing (File No. 9800090) to the Commission for approval on July 30, 1997. The tariff filing was designed to add Campus Talk Options to its Campus Talk Dedicated Service. The Commission issued its order suspending the tariff sheets and setting an early prehearing conference on September 11. The tariff sheets were suspended until July 13, 1998.

As of this date, no procedural schedule or request for extension of time has been filed. The Commission will direct the parties to file either a proposed procedural schedule or a stipulation and agreement no later than November 12. No further extensions of time will be granted.
