## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

On March 5, 1997, IDB Worldcom Services, Inc. (IDB) filed a document entitled "Surrender of Certificate of Service Authority" with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission). The document indicates that IDB wishes to surrender the certificate of service authority issued to it in Case No. TA-94-287, that it has no customers in Missouri, and that surrender of the certificate will not be detrimental to the public interest. The document is verified by the secretary of the corporation, who indicates that he is a duly elected officer of IDB and is authorized by its Board of Directors to sign the document surrendering the corporation's Missouri Certificate of Service Authority.

On June 27 the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum containing its recommendation. Staff notes that IDB is a competitive telecommunications company which was certificated to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Case No. TA-94-287. Additionally, Staff notes that IDB states it has no customers in Missouri. Based upon the document received from IDB, Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order canceling the Certificate of Service Authority previously granted to IDB, along with IDB's accompanying tariff.

The Commission has reviewed the document filed by IDB, along

with Staff's recommendation, and finds that it would be appropriate to cancel the Certificate of Service Authority held by IDB, as requested by the corporation. Thus, the Commission will cancel both IDB's Certificate of Service Authority and accompanying tariff.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Certificate of Service Authority granted to IDB Worldcom Services, Inc. on May 11, 1994 in Case No. TA-94-287 is canceled.
- 2. That the current tariff of IDB Worldcom Services, Inc. is canceled.
  - 3. That this case is closed.
  - 4. That this order shall become effective on July 22, 1997.
