

ORDER ESTABLISHING AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 7, 2000, Fiber Four Corporation d/b/a KLM Long Distance, d/b/a Holway Long Distance, d/b/a IAMO Long Distance, and d/b/a Rock Port Long Distance (Fiber Four) filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) a motion for the suspension of the procedural schedule ordered by the Commission on November 18, 1999.

Fiber Four stated that part of the procedural schedule had already been fulfilled, i.e., on January 20, 2000, Fiber Four filed direct testimony and on February 17, 2000, the Staff of the Commission, Office

of the Public Counsel, and AT&T Communications of the Southwest filed rebuttal testimony. Fiber Four stated that the parties have had discussions which they believe may lead to the filing of a stipulation and agreement which would resolve all issues. Fiber Four stated that, in order to give the parties time to negotiate an agreement, it was requesting that the procedural schedule be suspended for forty-five (45) days to allow the parties time to complete their settlement negotiations. Fiber Four stated that such a unanimous stipulation and agreement would likely result in the dismissal of the case and all that would be required of the Commission would be approval of the unanimous stipulation and agreement. If, Fiber Four stated, the parties are unable to negotiate an agreement within that period, they would suggest a new procedural schedule.

Fiber Four stated that all the parties had been contacted and all consented to its request for a suspension of the procedural schedule.

The Commission notes that this case was filed on July 15, 1999, and that the operation of law date is July 1, 2000. Thus, there is very little time which could be spared if an order granting Fiber Four's motion to suspend the procedural schedule were granted. The Commission will postpone the implementation of the remainder of the procedural schedule for forty-five (45) days, but will otherwise keep in effect all the other parts of the order establishing the procedural schedule which was filed on November 18, 1999. However, on the date indicated below, the parties shall file their surrebuttal and cross-rebuttal testimony or a unanimous stipulation and agreement.

The Commission will also order the evidentiary hearing set for March 29, 2000, be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following procedural schedule is established for this case:

Surrebuttal and cross-rebuttal of all parties	-	April 28, 2000 3:00 PM
List of issues; order of witnesses and cross examination	-	May 5, 2000 3:00 PM
Statement of the position of each party on each issue	-	May 11, 2000 3:00 PM
Evidentiary Hearing	-	May 23, 2000 9:00 AM

2. That the filings pursuant to the procedural schedule in ordered paragraph 1 need not be filed if the parties submit a unanimous stipulation and agreement on or before 3:00 p.m. on April 28, 2000.

3. That the evidentiary hearing set for March 29, 2000, is canceled.

4. That this order shall become effective on March 24, 2000.


