ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On June 10, 1998, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an Order Adopting Procedural Schedule, which provided for an evidentiary hearing to be held on September 9, 1998.

On September 3, 1998, the Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes, Recreational Vehicles and Modular Units of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and Ralph W. VanGennip and Arco Refrigeration Co., and the Missouri Manufactured Housing Association (collectively, the Parties) filed a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule. The motion notes that as a result of the Parties' continuing discussions following the prehearing conference on May 21, 1998, and the preparation of the Hearing Memorandum, the Parties have reached agreement on the interpretation of the electrical requirements pertaining to the installation of external air conditioning/heating units. The Parties are in the process of preparing a written stipulation and agreement setting forth the points agreed upon for filing with the Commission.

The motion also indicates that as a result of the agreement between the Parties, the evidentiary hearing scheduled for September 9,

1998, is no longer required. Consequently, the Parties request that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule in this proceeding for at least 30 days to grant the parties time to prepare and file a written stipulation and agreement with the Commission for its approval.

The Commission has reviewed the motion and finds that the request is reasonable and should be granted. The procedural schedule shall be suspended until October 19, 1998, a period of 40 days.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule filed by the Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes, Recreational Vehicles and Modular Units of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and Ralph W. VanGennip and Arco Refrigeration Co. and Missouri Manufactured Housing Association, is granted, and the procedural schedule is suspended until October 19, 1998, in order to allow the Parties time to complete and file a stipulation and agreement.

2. That this order shall become effective on September 8, 1998.
