ORDER GRANTING CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

On September 29, 1998, the Commission issued an Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity which required Four Seasons Water & Sewer Company (Four Seasons) to file a complete set of tariffs. On October 6, Four Seasons filed the tariff sheets required by the Commission's order.

On October 16, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum to the official case file. Staff states that it has reviewed the tariff sheets and is of the opinion that they comply with the Commission's order.

The Commission has reviewed Four Seasons's tariff sheets filing and the Staff's memorandum. Based on the Staff's memorandum, the Commission finds that the tariff sheets should be approved for service rendered on and after November 5, 1998.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Tariff No. 9900278, submitted in File No. SA-98-248, by Four Seasons Water and Sewer Company on December 18, 1997, is hereby approved for service on and after November 5, 1998:
