## **ORDER CLOSING CASE**

Pursuant to ordered paragraph 8 of the Commission's Order Approving Application to Reorganize Corporate Structure issued on September 30, 1997, Applicants are required to notify the Commission of the completion of the transactions within 10 days after completion. Counsel for the companies filed a letter on November 3 indicating that the corporate reorganization had been completed with the exception of two components. On February 4, 1998, the Commission issued its Order Directing Status Filing, which instructed Applicants to notify the Commission of the status of the transaction and make any appropriate compliance filings no later than February 16.

On February 13, Applicants filed a pleading which indicated that the merger of MFS Intelenet of Missouri, Inc. with and into WorldCom Technologies, Inc. was effective on December 30, 1997. The pleading also indicated that, as a result of a change in the Applicants' business plans, MFS Network Technologies, Inc. will remain in the corporate chain of ownership of WorldCom Technologies, Inc. The pleading further states that the transactions proposed in the joint application are now fully completed, and that the matter can be closed. The Commission finds that the corporate reorganization contemplated by the joint application has now been completed and Applicants have complied with ordered paragraph 8 of the Commission's Order Approving Application to Reorganize Corporate Structure, thus nothing remains to be done in this case. This case is therefore closed.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Case No. TM-98-15 is now closed.
- 2. This order shall become effective on March 16, 1998.
