ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On September 9, 1998, the Commission issued an Order Directing Compliance which ordered Tel-Save, Inc. d/b/a The Phone Company (Tele-Save) to send all of its customers a notice in compliance with the order directing compliance. Further, the Commission ordered Tel-Save to file a copy of the new notice or correction notice sent to the customers with the Commission by September 30, 1998. To date the Commission has not received this filing. Tel-Save shall have until March 22, 1999 to file this notice with the Commission or show cause why it should not be subject to penalties under sections 386.570 and 392.360, RSMo 1994, for failure to comply with the Commission's order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Tel-Save, Inc. d/b/a The Phone Company shall file a copy of the notice issued to customers in compliance with the Commission's September 9 order no later than March 22, 1999.

2. That this order shall become effective on March 11, 1999.
