## ORDER DIRECTING THE FILING OF SUGGESTIONS IN SUPPORT OF STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

Union Electric Company (UE) filed an application for approval of the funding level of nuclear decommissioning costs for its Callaway plant with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) on September 3, 1996. On April 22, 1997, the parties filed a Unanimous Stipulation And Agreement (Stipulation). However, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) has not to date filed its suggestions in support of the Stipulation, and no further formal action has been taken since the Stipulation was filed over four months ago. The Commission finds that Staff should be directed to file its suggestions in support of the Stipulation by October 24, or an explanation of why it is unable to comply with this directive. In addition, the Commission finds that the suggestions in support should address UE's request for a waiver of the Commission's quarterly funding requirement, and should address how the Stipulation will affect or will be affected by the requirements of the Internal Revenue Service.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Staff of the Commission shall file its suggestions in support of the Unanimous Stipulation And Agreement no later than October 24, 1997 or, in the alternative, an explanation of why it is unable to comply with this directive.
- 2. That this order shall become effective on September 24, 1997.
