On March 6, 2000, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company (MGE or Company) of Kansas City, Missouri, filed tariff sheets with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) to comply with the Commission's ORDER GRANTING CERTIFICATE (Order) issued in this case on February 29, 2000. In its letter accompanying this filing, MGE is requesting expedited approval of these revised tariff sheets because they are in compliance with the Order and the Order does not become. effective until the revised tariff sheets are approved. However, the Company did not request a date for expedited approval, the tariff sheets provide for the required 30 days notice by having an April 5, 2000, effective date.

The purpose of this filing is to modify the Company's Index of Certificated Areas and its Map of Certificated Areas to include the additional service area that will expand MGE's existing certificated area as allowed in the Commission's Order. The Order stated that the certificate will become effective simultaneous with the effective date of the tariff sheets modifying its gas service areas to reflect the additional service area.

Staff has reviewed this filing, and MGE's request for expedited approval of these tariff sheets. Staff is of the opinion that this filing is in compliance with the Commission's Order and has no objection to the Company's request for expedited approval. Therefore, Staff recommends that the following tariff sheets filed on March 6, 2000, be allowed to become effective on an expedited basis:
