On July 19, 1999 Grand River Communications, Inc. d/b/a Lathrop Long Distance (LLD) filed an application requesting a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services. A proposed tariff with an effective date of September 2, 1999 was also filed. The application was assigned Case No. TA-2000-35 and the tariff was assigned Tariff Number 0000062. On July 27, 1999 The Commission issued a Notice of Applications setting August 11, 1999 as the intervention deadline the case. On August 6, 1999 AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T) filed an Application to Intervene and Motion to Consolidate this case with its identical twin application Grand River Communications, Inc. d/b/a Grand River Long Distance (GRLD), Case No. TA-2000-33.

On August 16, 1999 /LLD and GRLD filed a joint Response to AT&T's Application to Intervene and Motion to Consolidate. On August 17, 1999 Staff filed a Motion for Leave to Late File Response and a Response to AT&T's Application to Intervene and Motion to Consolidate. On August 20, 1999 LLD submitted a request for tariff extension to September 13, 1999 and substitute pages. These were reviewed and found acceptable.
