On November 24, 1999, Madison Dearborn Capital Partners III, L.P. (MDCP) and Dakota Services Limited (Dakota), filed a Joint Application (Application) asking the Commission to approve, *nunc pro tunc*, the transfer of control (merger) of Dakota, a certificated competitive interexchange and non-switched local exchange carrier, with @link Merger Sub, Inc., controlled by MDCP, and a name change to @link Networks, Inc. d/b/a At Link Networks, Inc. (@link). Concurrently, proposed tariff sheets were filed to replace references to Dakota with @link with an effective date of December 24, 1999. On December 7, 1999, at the request of the Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff), @link extended the effective date of the proposed tariff sheets to December 31. On December 10, 1999, @link submitted substitute sheets to correct minor errors in the text of its previously filed sheets. On December 17, again at Staff's request, @link extended the effective date of the tariff sheets to January 5, 2000. On December 20, 1999, @link submitted substitute sheets making additional minor changes to its previously filed sheets.

MDCP and @link (Applicants) state that notification was filed with the Commission on June 21, 1999, to inform the Commission of the merger and name change because they believed that no approval for the transactions was necessary. They further state that @link currently has no Missouri customers and therefore, there was no effect upon Missouri customers. Applicants also state that there should be no impact on tax revenues of any political subdivision in Missouri, and that there are no pending or final judgements against them involving service to customers or rates charged, and that the requested approval will serve the public interest.

The Staff has reviewed the Application and proposed tariff sheets, as substituted, and believes the merger should be approved prospectively and the application and proposed tariff sheets, as substituted, should be approved. Staff is not aware of any other filings that affect, or are affected by, the instant filings.
