ORDER APPROVING TARIFF PURSUANT TO COMMISSION ORDER AND CLOSING DOCKET

On August 26, 1997, the Commission issued its order approving a certificate of convenience and necessity for Kansas City Power and Light Company (KCPL), allowing KCPL to reroute three 161 kV transmission lines outside its service territory. As part of that order, the Commission instructed KCPL to file tariffs reflecting the concise route description and territorial boundaries granted by the new certificate.

On November 5 KCPL filed a substitute tariff sheet and original map No. 8 to replace Second Revised Sheet No. 8, reflecting corrections suggested by the Staff to KCPL's original compliance filing. The substitute sheet bears an effective date of November 24.

On November 10 the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation. In that recommendation the Staff states that the current filing contains concise route descriptions and the territorial boundaries granted by the certificate together with a map showing the route of the three transmission lines. The Staff continues that it has reviewed the substitute tariff filing, finds it in compliance with the Commission's order granting a certificate and recommends approval.

The Commission has reviewed the KCPL filing and the Staff recommendation and finds the substitute filing to be in compliance with the Commission's order of April 26. The Commission will approve the tariff for service on or after November 24.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following substitute tariff sheet, filed November 5, 1997, by Kansas City Power and Light Company, is hereby approved for service on or after November 24, 1997:

Second Revised Sheet No. 8 Canceling First Revised Sheet No. 8
