# ORDER APPROVING INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Network International, L.C. (NIL) applied to the Public Service Commission on September 25, 1998, for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Section 392.440, RSMo 1994<sup>1</sup>. NIL asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and waive certain statutes and rules as authorized by Sections 392.361 and 392.420. NIL is a Virginia corporation, with its principal office located at 12126 Darnestown Road, Suite 6, Gaithersburg, Maryland 20878.

The Commission issued a Notice of Applications and Opportunity to Intervene on October 6, directing parties wishing to intervene to file their requests by October 21. The requirement for a hearing is met when the opportunity for hearing has been provided and no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence. State ex rel.

Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989). Since no one has asked permission to intervene or requested a hearing, the Commission may grant the relief requested based on the verified application.

NIL filed a proposed tariff in conjunction with its application and filed substitute sheets on October 15. The tariff's effective date is November 9. NIL's tariff describes the rates, rules, and regulations it intends to use, identifies NIL as a competitive company, and lists the waivers requested. NIL intends to provide interexchange telecommunications services including 1+, 800/888/877 Services, and Directory Assistance services.

In its Memorandum filed on October 28, the Staff of the Commission stated that NIL's proposed services are similar to existing IXC offerings. Staff recommended that the Commission grant NIL a certificate of service authority, competitive status, and waiver of the statutes and rules listed in the Notice. Staff recommended that the Commission approve the proposed tariff as amended to become effective on November 9.

The Commission finds that competition in the intrastate interexchange telecommunications market is in the public interest and NIL should be granted a certificate of service authority. The Commission finds that the services NIL proposes to offer are competitive and NIL should be classified as a competitive company. The Commission finds that waiving the statutes and Commission rules set out in the ordered paragraph below is reasonable and not detrimental to the public interest.

The Commission finds that NIL's proposed tariff details the services, equipment, and pricing it proposes to offer, and is similar to tariffs approved for other Missouri certificated interexchange carriers. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff filed on September 25 shall be approved as amended to become effective on November 9.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Network International, L.C., is granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, subject to all applicable statutes and Commission rules except as specified in this order.
- 2. That Network International, L.C., is classified as a competitive telecommunications company. Application of the following statutes and regulatory rules shall be waived:
