ORDER APPROVING INTERIM NEELYVILLE DISTRICT RATES

United Cities Gas Company (United) of Brentwood, Tennessee, submitted a tariff sheet to the Commission on July 29, 1997, carrying an effective date of September 1, 1997. The tariff sheet is designed to change Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors for its Neelyville District as a result of a decrease in the spot market cost of natural gas. The effect of this change will decrease United's annualized revenues by approximately \$7,800. The impact on a typical residential space heating customer using 30 Ccf of natural gas in the month of September will be a decrease of \$0.40, or 1.5%.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum stating that the change in United's PGA was calculated in conformance with its approved PGA Clause and recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheet to become effective on September 1, 1997. Staff recommended that the tariff sheet be approved on an interim basis, subject to refund, until the Commission makes its final determinations in Case Nos. GR-96-197 and GR-97-259.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the proposed tariff conforms to United's Commission-approved PGA Clause and is therefore reasonable. After

considering Staff's recommendation, the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed tariff sheet should be approved to become effective on and after the requested effective date of September 1, 1997, interim subject to refund.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheet submitted on July 29, 1997, by United Cities Gas Company of Brentwood, Tennessee, for the purpose of reflecting changes in rates for its natural gas for its Neelyville District, is approved on an interim basis, subject to refund, to become effective on September 1, 1997. The tariff sheet approved is:
