ORDER DIRECTING FILING A MORE DEFINITE STATEMENT

On October 16, 2001, Respondents filed a Motion to Dismiss Complainant Moody from the pending complaint. In support of this motion, Respondents assert that Complainant Moody has made no allegations of any wrongful act on the part of Respondents towards Complainant Moody. Respondents further assert that even if Complainant Moody were 100% shareholder of Sterling's Market Place, Complainant Moody would still lack standing to dispute wrongs allegedly done to Sterling's Market Place.

The pleadings thus far do not indicate whether Sterling's Market Place is incorporated, or organized in another manner. This information is necessary for the Commission to respond to Respondents' Motion to Dismiss Complainant. It is likewise essential in properly pleading this complaint.

The Commission directs Complainants to file a more definite statement concerning Complainant Moody's association with Sterling's Market Place and Complainant Moody's relationship to all alleged occurrences. Complainants shall file their statement not later than Friday, November 2, 2001.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Complainants file a more definite statement regarding the foregoing subject matter not later than Friday, November 2, 2001.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on October 24, 2001.
