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1, 1995.

After reviewing Staff's recommendation and request, and for good cause shown pursuant to Section 393.140(11) RSMo 1986, the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed tariff sheet, as substituted, should be allowed to become effective on and after the requested effective date, December 1, 1994, interim subject to refund. Fidelity is reminded, however, that, in the future, should it not be able to submit its ACA filing in a timely manner, the proper procedure would be to file an application for a one-time variance from its PGA Clause to allow it to file its ACA tariff sheet in a manner inconsistent with its tariffed procedure.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheet filed November 4, 1994, by Fidelity Natural Gas, Inc. of Sullivan, Missouri, for the purpose of reflecting a net decrease in the PGA factors as a result of a decrease in its gas costs and an increase in its ACA factor, as substituted, be, and the same is, hereby authorized to become effective on and after December 1, 1994, interim subject to refund.

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2. That the Commission's Procurement Analysis Department be given the time necessary to conduct its audit of this ACA period and submit its results and recommendations regarding this ACA on or before September 1, 1995.

3. That this order shall become effective on December 1, 1994.
