## ORDER APPROVING INTERIM BOWLING GREEN DISTRICT RATES EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 1995

On March 1, 1995, United Cities Gas Company (Company) of Brentwood, Tennessee, filed with this Commission for approval, a tariff sheet which reflects changes in the Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors for its Bowling Green District resulting from a decrease in spot market gas costs and the termination of a positive balancing refund factor that was initiated April 1, 1994. Additionally, the Avoided Commodity Cost for Transportation Customers will decrease.

Case No. GR-95-197, under which this tariff sheet was filed, was established to address Company's PGA factors that will be reviewed in its 1994-1995 Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) filing. Case No. GR-94-63 was established to address Company's PGA factors that will be reviewed in its 1993-1994 ACA filing.

The Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) has reviewed the filing and is of the opinion that the proposed changes comply with the current PGA Clause. Additionally, Staff recommends that the proposed tariff sheet be approved, interim subject to refund, pending a final Commission decision in Case No. GR-94-63.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's recommendation and is of the opinion that the proposed tariff sheet should be allowed to become effective on and after the requested effective date of April 1, 1995, interim subject to refund.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheet filed March 1, 1995, by United Cities Gas Company of Brentwood, Tennessee, for the purpose of reflecting changes in rates for its natural gas and transportation service in its Bowling Green District be, and it is, hereby authorized to become effective on and after April 1, 1995, interim subject to refund.
