The Missouri Public Service Commission reminds all parties that only a licensed attorney may represent another person before the Commission.¹ A corporation is a person at law separate from its all incorporators, directors, officers, shareholders and employees.² Therefore, only a licensed attorney may represent a corporation before the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Only a licensed attorney may represent any other person in this action.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
