## **ORDER AND NOTICE**

McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. (McLeodUSA Telecom) filed an application on January 14, 1998, for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service and local exchange telecommunications service in the State of Missouri under 4 CSR 240 - 2.060(4). Specifically, McLeodUSA Telecom wishes to provide facilities-based and resold services in all the exchanges currently served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, GTE Midwest Incorporated, and United Telephone Company of Missouri, d/b/a Sprint. McLeodUSA Telecom asked to be classified as a competitive company and receive a lesser degree of regulation as permitted by Sections 392.361 and 392.420, RSMo.<sup>1</sup> McLeodUSA Telecom requested a temporary waiver of 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H) that requires an applicant to file a tariff simultaneously with its application until it has executed interconnection agreements with the underlying CLECs and those agreements have been approved by the Commission. Finally, McLeodUSA Telecom requested waiver of the following statutes and Commission rules:


