ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

Digital Services Corporation (DSC) filed an Application to Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Tariffs on September 30, 1998, asking the Commission to cancel its interexchange certificate and tariff, issued by the Commission on June 26, 1996, in Case No. TA-96-397. DSC stated it had no customers or facilities in Missouri, that surrender of its certificate was not detrimental to the public interest, and that it wished to have its certificate canceled.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a Memorandum on October 9, 1998 regarding the proposed cancellation of DSC's certificate and related tariff. Staff stated it had reviewed DSC's application and had no objection to the Commission issuing an order canceling the certificate and related tariff.

Section 392.410 gives the Commission authority to cancel a telecommunications company's certificate of service authority. The Commission has reviewed DSC's application, Staff's memorandum, and the official file and finds that the interexchange certificate and tariff granted to DSC in Case No. TA-96-397 shall be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the interexchange certificate and tariff granted to Digital Services Corporation (DSC) in Case No. TA-96-397 are canceled.
2. That this order shall become effective on October 30, 1998.
3. That this case shall be closed on November 2, 1998.
