## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

On October 21, 1997, Talton Holdings, Inc., Talton Invision, Inc. and Invision Telecom, Inc. filed a joint application requesting approval of the sale of assets to Talton Invision, Inc. and the Commission issued its Order Approving Sale of Certain Assets and Granting Certificate of Service Authority on February 11, 1998. Talton Invision, Inc. filed an Application to Cancel Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Intrastate Interexchange Telecommunications Service on February 23, 1998, asking the Commission to cancel its interexchange certificate which it had been issued by the Commission on February 11 in this case. Invision, Inc. stated its current business plans only involved providing payphone services to inmates in Missouri, did not require its current interexchange certificate, and it wished to have its certificate Talton Invision, Inc. also requested the Commission grant it a certificate of service authority to provide payphone services in This requested was addressed in Case No. TA-98-367 and Missouri. therefore does not need to be addressed in this order.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a Memorandum on October 9 regarding the proposed cancellation of Talton Invision, Inc.'s certificate. Staff stated it had reviewed Talton Invision, Inc.'s application and had no objection to the Commission issuing an order canceling the certificate previously issued to Talton Invision, Inc.

Section 392.410 gives the Commission authority to cancel a telecommunications company's certificate of service authority. The Commission has reviewed Talton Invision, Inc.'s application, Staff's recommendation, and the official file and finds that the interexchange certificate granted to Talton Invision, Inc. in Case No. TM-98-171 shall be canceled.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the interexchange certificate granted to Talton Invision, Inc. in Case No. TM-98-171 is canceled.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on December 17, 1998.
  - 3. That this case shall be closed on December 18, 1998.


