ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANNUAL REPORT

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-10.080, "[a]ll public utilities subject to the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file an annual report with the commission on or before April 15 of each year." On April 9, 1998, Global TeleMedia International, Inc. (GTMI) filed a request with the Commission for a thirty-day extension of time to file its 1997 annual report. GTMI stated in its request that it will not receive the results of its annual audit prior to the April 15 deadline, and that information contained in the annual audit results is necessary to fully and accurately complete the annual report.

On April 22, the Staff of the Commission filed a memorandum recommending that the request be approved. Staff also stated that GTMI received its certificate on April 30, 1997.

The Commission stresses that GTMI should strive in the future to meet required filing deadlines, however, the Commission determines that the request for extension should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Global TeleMedia International, Inc. shall have until May 15, 1998, in which to file its 1997 annual report with the Commission.

- 2. That this order shall become effective on May 1, 1998.
- 3. That this case may be closed on May 12, 1998.
