ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION REGARDING FINAL DISPOSITION OF CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

On June 7, 2007, Central Jefferson County Utilities, Inc. ("Central Jefferson") filed its June status report in this matter. Central Jefferson asserts that this will be its final status report because the transactions authorized by the Commission's February 8, 2007 Report and Order are now complete and the transfer of assets closed on June 1, 2007.

In its Report and Order, the Commission stated that after the transactions were complete it would relieve Central Jefferson of its obligation to provide water and sewer service to the public in its assigned service area and would cancel its certificate and tariff. Consequently, the Commission will direct its Staff to confirm that the authorized transfer of assets is complete, identify the Case Number in which Central Jefferson was granted its certificate, identify the tariff by tracking number that Central Jefferson is currently operating under and provide a recommendation whether the Commission should cancel Central Jefferson's tariff and certificate.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. No later than June 28, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Commission shall

file a report and recommendation as directed in the body of this order.

2. This order shall become effective on June 7, 2007.
