ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On April 25, 2008,¹ the Commission adopted a procedural schedule in this matter culminating with an evidentiary hearing to be held on July 1-2. On June 9, the Commission modified the procedural schedule and re-set the hearing dates for July 29-30.

Additional conflicts have developed in relation to the availability of witnesses and the filing of the reports of the outside experts that the Commission retained for this matter. Consequently, the Commission's Staff, without opposition, has requested that the evidentiary hearing in this matter be rescheduled to August 13 and 14. The Commission finds this request to be reasonable and shall grant it. Because the Commission is rescheduling the hearing dates the Commission will also re-set the deadlines for filing the issues and witness list and for the filing of the parties' position statements.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The current deadline for the filing of the List of Issues, List of Witnesses, Order of Witnesses, Order of Cross-Examination and Order of Opening Statements is canceled.

2. The evidentiary hearing scheduled for July 29 and 30, 2008 is canceled.

3. The following modifications to the procedural schedule are hereby ordered:

List of Issues, List of Witnesses, Order of Witnesses, Order of Cross and Order of Opening Statements	- July 31, 2008
Position Statements	- August 4, 2008
Evidentiary Hearing	- August 13-14, 2008, beginning at 8:30 a.m.

4. The hearing will be held in the offices of the Missouri Public Service Commission at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 5. There are no other modifications to the procedural schedule in this matter, and all other portions of the Commission's April 25, 2008 order establishing the procedural schedule in this matter remain in full force and effect.
