### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission approve the Interconnection Agreement of GTE Midwest Incorporated d/b/a Verizon Midwest and Direct2Internet Corporation.
- 2. The Commission's authority to approve or reject this interconnection agreement is pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 3. The Staff concludes that the Interconnection Agreement does not appear to discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the agreement and the Agreement does not appear to be against the public interest, convenience or necessity.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends approval of the Interconnection Agreement.

## Attachment Notes:

### Latest Genesis Agreement Comparison to Current Approved Agreements

The new Agreement is similar in overall format to the Resale Agreement between Verizon and PCS referenced above, approved effective February 17, 2001. The instant Agreement includes similar terms and conditions and seven attachments.

In general, the arrangement of the new Agreement is similar in format and content to the Verizon/PCS Resale Agreement.

- The Agreement section is similar.
- The Glossary section is similar, but expanded.
- The Additional Services and Resale Attachments are similar.
- The Pricing Attachment is similar in form, but much expanded to allow for facilities-base.

The Interconnection, Unbundled Network Element (UNE) and Collocation Attachments are similar to those Attachments of the Interconnection Agreement between GTE and STN, referenced above, approved effective August 10, 2000.

- Rates in the Pricing Attachment are similar only for certain elements, varying in type and layout.
- The 911 Attachment is new, separated out and expanded from the earlier attachments.
