STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) and for its staff recommendation in this matter respectfully states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Commission grant approval of the Interconnection Agreement filed by TDS Telecommunications Corporation (TDS) and Universal Telecom, Inc. (Universal). Staff notes that the Interconnection Agreement is an agreement between Universal and three subsidiaries of TDS including: New London Telephone Company, Orchard Farm Telephone Company, and The Stoutland Telephone Company.
- 2. The terms of the Interconnection Agreement do not appear to discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the Interconnection Agreement and do not appear to be against the public interest, convenience, or necessity. Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §252(e), the Commission is to approve a negotiated interconnection agreement unless the terms of the agreement discriminate against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or implementation of the agreement or any portion thereof is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

WHEREFORE, because the terms set forth in this agreement satisfy the standard set forth in 47 U.S.C. §252(e) in that they do not appear to discriminate against telecommunications

carriers not a party to the Interconnection Agreement and do not appear to be against the public interest, convenience, and necessity, the Staff recommends the Commission grant approval of the Interconnection Agreement.
