COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant approval of the submitted Resale Interconnection Agreement between Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and Delta Phones, Inc. The Staff believes the submitted agreement meets the limited requirements of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 in that the agreement 1) does not appear to discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the Agreement and 2) does not appear to be against the public interest, convenience or necessity.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission enter an Order Approving Interconnection Agreement, approving the agreement, ordering the parties to submit any modifications or amendments to the agreement to the Staff for review and directing the parties to

file with the Staff a copy of the agreement with the pages numbered consecutively in the lower right-hand corner.
