STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation states:

1. In Case No. TM-2001-628 in an Order Approving Mergers issued on October 30, 2001, the Commission granted approval of certain merger transactions involving Qwest Communications Corporation, LCI International Telecom Corp., Phoenix Network, Inc., and USLD Communications. The Commission ordered further specific things related to the merger transactions.

2. As part of the Order in Case No. TM-2001-628, the Commission ordered that Qwest Communications Corporation shall file amendments to its tariffs in this case to include the customers of LCI International Telecom Corp. no later than 30 days from the date of the consummation of the merger and with a proposed 30 day effective date. The Commission also ordered Qwest Communications Corporation to file amendments to its tariffs to include the customers of Phoenix Network, Inc. Those amendments were also to be filed in this case no later than 30 days from the date of the consummation of the merger and with a proposed 30-day effective date.


3. On January 8, 2002, Qwest Communications Corporation filed its Notice of Consummation of Mergers and reported it to the Commission as having been completed on December 31, 2001. Other parts of the transactions were completed on December 28, 2001.

4. On January 30, 2002, Qwest Communications Corporation submitted tariff amendments pursuant to the Commission Order in TM-2001-628. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff states that the tariff amendments are in compliance with the Order and recommends approval of the tariff amendments.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission approve the proposed Qwest Communications Corporation Tariff P.S.C.MO.No. 1, and P.S.C.MO.No.3, with a proposed effective date of March 4, 2002, and close the case.
