STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE TARIFF SHEETS

Comes now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by counsel, and for its recommendation to approve tariff sheets, to become effective July 1, 2009, states:

- 1. On June 10, 2009, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and Authorizing Tariff Filing* in this case, which it made effective June 23, 2009.
- 2. In ordered paragraphs 5 and 6 of its *Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and Authorizing Tariff Filing* the Commission stated:
 - 5. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company is authorized to file tariffs in compliance with the terms of the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.
 - 6. Tariffs filed in accordance with Ordered Paragraph No. 5 shall be filed with an effective date of July 1, 2009.
- 3. In response, on June 17, 2009, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed thirteen (13) tariff sheets bearing an effective date of July 1, 2009.
- 4. The Staff has reviewed the filed tariff sheets to determine if they comport with the Commission's *Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and Authorizing Tariff Filing*. The Staff concludes they do. In the attached Memorandum (Appendix A), the Staff recommends the Commission issue an Order that both (1) approves the tariff sheets listed in Appendix A, as filed on June 17, 2009, to become effective July 1, 2009 and (2) cancels KCP&L

Greater Missouri Operations Company's present tariff sheets listed to be canceled in Appendix

A. The Staff notes here that the Commission's Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and

Agreement and Authorizing Tariff Filing is not effective until June 23, 2009; therefore, if

rehearing of that order is requested and granted by the Commission before June 23, 2009, both

the basis for the Staff's recommendation and the Staff's recommendation might change.

5. Section 393.140(11) RSMo 2000 requires proposed changes to tariffs not go into

effect with less than thirty (30) days' notice, unless the Commission determines otherwise for

"good cause shown." The Commission determined otherwise in its June 10, 2009 Order

Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and Authorizing Tariff Filing that becomes

effective June 23, 2009, unless rehearing is requested and granted before that Order becomes

effective on June 23, 2009.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order that (1)

approves the tariff sheets listed in Appendix A, as filed on June 17, 2009 to become effective

July 1, 2009 and (2) cancels KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's present tariff

sheets listed to be canceled in Appendix A.

On June 17, 2009, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) filed with the Commission thirteen (13) rate tariff sheets with an issue date of June 17, 2009, and a proposed effective date of July 1, 2009. These tariff sheets are designed to comply with Ordered Paragraphs 5 and 6 of the Commission's June 10, 2009 Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and Authorizing Tariff Filing (Order). Ordered Paragraphs 1, 5 and 6 of the Order state:

1. The Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement filed on May 13, 2009, is hereby approved as the resolution of all factual issues encompassed within that Agreement in case number HR-2009-0092.

* * * *

- 5. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company is authorized to file tariffs in compliance with the terms of the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.
- 6. Tariffs filed in accordance with Ordered Paragraph No. 5 shall be filed with an effective date of July 1, 2009.

In the Discussion section on page 9 of the Order, the Commission stated:

Furthermore, because the exemplar tariffs have been on file at the Commission since May 13, 2009, and all parties agree to those tariffs becoming effective on July 1, 2009, the Commission finds that good cause exists to approve revised tariffs without the need for those tariffs having been filed for an additional 30 days.

The Staff has reviewed the filed tariff sheets, and is of the opinion that they are in compliance with the Commission's Order. Staff therefore recommends that the Commission approve the

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following proposed tariff sheets, as filed on June 17, 2009, to become effective on July 1, 2009 as requested by GMO, or permit the tariff sheets to go into effect by operation-of-law:
