STAFF'S RESPONSE TO KCPL'S RESPONSE TO STAFF'S FINAL INCIDENT REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and in Response to Kansas City Power & Light's (KCPL) Response to Staff's Final Incident Report states:

- 1. In its February 1, 2001 Order, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) ordered KCPL to respond to Staff's Final Incident Report (Staff's Report) concerning the Hawthorn 5 Boiler explosion and in the same Order directed Staff to respond to KCPL's Response to Staff's Final Incident Report.
- 2. Since Staff, the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC), and KCPL have reached agreement concerning the recommendations contained in Staff's Report and filed a Stipulation and Agreement (Stipulation) detailing those agreements, this Response is limited to advising the Commission that an Agreement, which is acceptable to the Staff, OPC and KCPL, has been reached concerning implementation of the Recommendations.
- 3. All of Staff's recommendations are fully addressed in the Stipulation. Staff will file its Memorandum in Support of the Stipulation and Agreement within 30 days of this filing.
