ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF CORPORATE NAME AND APPROVING ADOPTION NOTICE

Westinghouse Electric Corporation d/b/a Westinghouse Communications, a Pennsylvania corporation, submitted an adoption notice on February 9, 1998, designed to reflect its change of corporate name to "CBS Corporation d/b/a Westinghouse Communications" (hereafter referred to as Westinghouse). The company was certificated to provide interexchange telecommunications services on August 30, 1995, in Case No. TA-96-12. Westinghouse included with its filing an Amended Certificate of Authority from the Missouri Secretary of State reflecting its new corporate name. Westinghouse's adoption notice carries an effective date of March 13, 1998.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum on March 4 stating that it had reviewed the company's filing and adoption notice and had no objection to their approval. Staff recommended that the name change be recognized and the adoption notice approved to become effective on March 13.

The Commission has reviewed Westinghouse's filing, the adoption notice, and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the change of name

should be recognized. The Commission further finds that the adoption notice reflecting that change of name should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the change of corporate name from "Westinghouse Electric Corporation d/b/a Westinghouse Communications" to "CBS Corporation d/b/a Westinghouise Communications" is acknowledged.
- That the adoption notice denominated P.S.C. Mo. No. 1,
 Original Adoption Notice Page is approved to become effective on March 13,
 1998.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on March 13, 1998.


