ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

GTE Communications Corporation (GTE) has requested that information contained in its 1997 annual report for alternative basic local exchange carrier service be treated as confidential by the Commission. On March 1, 1999, the Commission issued an order directing the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) to file a recommendation regarding this request. On March 22 Staff filed a response and a motion for an additional 30 days time to resolve some of its concerns and engage in further discussions with GTE. There were no objections to Staff's motion.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and determines that Staff's request is reasonable. Therefore, Staff will be allowed additional time in which to file a recommendation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Staff is given until May 19, 1999, in which to file its recommendation concerning whether the Commission should treat portions of GTE Communications Corporation's 1997 annual report for alternative basic local exchange carrier service as confidential.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 29, 1999.
