RESPONDENTS' MOTION FOR REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Come now respondents, AmerenUE, Union Electric Co. d/b/a AmerenUE, and Mike Foy, Leroy Ettling and Sherry Moschner, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.110, and for their Motion for Revised Procedural Schedule state as follows:

- 1. On March 25, 2002, the parties submitted their Proposed Procedural Schedule in this matter.
- 2. Before an Order was entered adopting the parties' Proposed Procedural Schedule, complainants have filed a Motion for Revised Procedural Schedule, along with a proposed Revised Procedural Schedule.
- 3. Respondents do not oppose complainants' Motion for Revised Procedural Schedule.
- 4. However, counsel for respondents learned only late last week that respondent Leroy Ettling will not be available to appear at the hearing proposed for July 8, 9 and 10, 2002.
