## RESPONSE OF LACLEDE GAS COMPANY TO UNION ELECTRIC COMPANY'S MOTION

COMES NOW Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede") and in response to the "Motion to Cancel or for Continuance, Clarification and Reconsideration of Commission Order Setting Hearing Dated January 31, 1997" ("Motion") filed in this proceeding by Union Electric Company ("UE") hereby states as follows:

1. On or about July 12, 1996, certain parties to this proceeding, including UE, the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff ("Staff") and the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") executed a Stipulation and Agreement in this proceeding, recommending that the Commission approve the merger proposed herein, subject to the terms and conditions set forth therein.

2. Laclede is a party to this proceeding, but it did not sign the Stipulation and Agreement. In the September 5, 1996 hearing convened to permit the presentation of the Stipulation and Agreement and the receipt of prefiled testimony into the record, Laclede stated that it did not oppose the Stipulation and Agreement.

> 3. Subsequent to the September 5, 1996 hearing, pursuant to the Commission's request, UE, the Staff and OPC filed testimony concerning market power. In an order issued on January 31, 1997, the Commission scheduled a hearing on February 11, 1997 to permit cross-examination of the witnesses sponsoring the market power testimony.

> 4. In response to the January 31, 1997 order, UE filed its Motion. In its Motion, UE states that all of the parties to this proceeding continue to support and recommend approval of the Stipulation and Agreement.

5. Laclede's position in this proceeding is unchanged. While Laclede does not oppose adoption of the Stipulation and Agreement, it also does not actively support it or recommend its approval.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated herein, Laclede respectfully requests that the Commission correctly characterize Laclede's position in any orders which may be issued in this proceeding.
