ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On February 16, 2016, House Springs Sewer Company, Inc. ("HSSC") and Jefferson County Public Sewer District ("JCPSD") filed a joint application ("Application") with the Commission. The Application seeks authority for JCPSD to buy the assets HSSC uses to provide sewer service to approximately 1,100 customers in Jefferson County, and then for JCPSD to provide sewer service to those customers.

The Commission will direct notice of the Application be given to the Jefferson County Commission, local newspapers, members of the General Assembly representing residents of Jefferson County, and the General Counsel for the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. The Commission will also set a deadline for interested parties to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order and the Application to the County Commission of Jefferson County, Missouri, and the General Counsel for the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Jefferson County, Missouri, and to the media serving Jefferson County, Missouri.

3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than March 8, 2016. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System ("EFIS") or with the Secretary of the Commission. Comments on the application can also be made in EFIS.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
