Comes now Snappy Phone of Texas, Inc., D/B/A ("Snappy Phone") and hereby files this Application for Approval of its Interconnection Agreement (the Agreement) under the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("FTA 96") between Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, LP d/b/a SBC Missouri (SWC Missouri) and Snappy Phone, and respectfully states as follows:

#### I. APPLICANT

Applicant Snappy Phone is a corporation duly organized and existing and by virtue of laws of the State of Texas and is authorized to conduct business in the State of Missouri. See Certificate of Authority filed as Exhibit A in Case No. TA-2000-372. The principal office of Snappy Phone of Texas, Inc., d/b/a Snappy Phone, is located at 6901 W. 70th Street, P.O. Box 29620, Shreveport, LA 71149. Snappy Phone is a provider of facilities-based and resold basic local exchange telecommunication services, local exchange telecommunications services. Its Application for Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Basic Local and Interexchange Telecommunications Services was granted by the Public Service Commission in Case No. TA-2000-372. ### II. INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT REACHED

Snappy Phone presents to this Commission for approval the Agreement executed pursuant to the terms of Section 252(i) of the Act. Snappy Phone and SWBT have executed the Agreement between Snappy Phone and SBC Missouri on April 24, 2003, respectively. The Agreement consists of one hundred nineteen (119) pages plus Exhibits and Appendixes. There are no outstanding issues between Snappy Phone and SBC Missouri which require mediation or arbitration.

### III. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

Snappy Phone seeks the Commission's approval of the Agreement, consistent with the provisions of the Federal Act and Missouri law. Snappy Phone believes that the implementation of this Agreement complies fully with Section 252(e) of the Federal Act because the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. The Agreement promotes diversity in providers, provides interconnectivity, and increases customer choices for

telecommunications services once Snappy Phone is certificated and has effective tariffs. Snappy Phone respectfully requests that the Commission grant expeditious approval of the Agreement, without change, suspension or other delay in its implementation. This is a bilateral agreement, reached as a result of negotiations and compromise between the parties.

#### IV. STANDARD FOR REVIEW

In addition to the applicable terms of Section 252(i), the statutory standards of review are set forth in Section 252(e) of the Federal Act which provides as follows:

\* \* \*

- (e) Approval by State Commission
  - (1) Approval required. Any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State commission. A State commission to which an agreement is submitted shall approve or reject the agreement, with written findings as to any deficiencies.
  - (2) Grounds for rejection. The State commission may only reject
    - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection(a) if it finds that
      - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
      - (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

The affidavit of Richard S. Brownlee, III, local counsel for Snappy Phone establishes that the Agreement submitted herein satisfies these standards. (Affidavit Attachment I).

#### V. MISSOURI LEGISLATION

The executed Agreement is consistent with Chapter 392 RSMo and is fundamentally an adoption of Interconnection Agreements previously approved by the Commission.

### VI. CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, Snappy Phone respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Interconnection Agreement between SBC Missouri and Snappy Phone as expeditiously as possible.


