RESPONSE OF INTERVENORS CITIES OF WARRENSBURG, ST. PETERS, O'FALLON, WELDON SPRING, ST. CHARLES COUNTY, WARRENSBURG INDUSTRIAL INTERVENORS AND CENTRAL MISSOURI STATE UNIVERSITY TO ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND DIRECTING FILING

COME NOW Intervenors Cities of Warrensburg, St. Peters, O'Fallon and Weldon Spring, The County of St. Charles, Warrensburg Industrial Intervenors and Central Missouri State University (hereinafter collectively referred to as the City of Warrensburg, et al.) and in response to the Commission's March 7, 2002 Order Setting Prehearing Conference and Directing Filing, State:

- 1. Intervenors City of Warrensburg, et al. were primarily interested in the issue of whether District Specific Pricing ("DSP") or Single Tariff Pricing ("STP") was the more just and reasonable rate design for the Missouri-American Water Company in these proceedings. The Commission's Final Report and Order determined that District Specific Pricing ("DSP") was the more appropriate rate design for Missouri-American.
- 2. The Commission's DSP holding was appealed by the City of St. Joseph and the Cole County Circuit Court affirmed the Commission's DSP holding. The Missouri Court of Appeals expressed no opinion on the issue when it remanded the case back to the Commission on other issues.

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3. The City of Warrensburg, et al. does not believe that the Commission's findings regarding DSP rate design is at issue on this remand. With regard to the other issues, the City of Warrensburg, et al. takes no position at this time.
