$\frac{\textbf{RESPONSE OF SPRINT MISSOURI, INC. TO RECORD QUESTION POSED}}{\textbf{AT PRE-HEARING}}$

As requested, the following is a summary of the records that Sprint Missouri, Inc. ("Sprint") is prepared to produce if and when ICG Telecom Group, Inc. ("ICG") transits traffic under its interconnection agreement with Sprint.

1. For any ICG traffic that is directly interconnected with Sprint in Missouri at one of its tandems:¹

ICG-originated calls involving local or optional calling scope traffic that transits

Sprint and terminates to a third party, Sprint will make a standard format 11-01 call

record for itself and one for the third party that terminates the call. This applies to all

local and optional (EAS or MCA) traffic, including local, reciprocal compensation traffic.

With respect to MCA traffic, Sprint does not pass a record as the Commission has ruled that it is bill and keep for the originating and terminating companies.

The above identifies the only type of traffic that will transit under Sprint's interconnection with ICG for termination to a third party ILEC.

¹ The traffic descriptions in this filing pertain to facilities-based and UNE-P traffic. Any resold service offered by ICG will be treated as Sprint originated traffic for records purposes. It is Sprint's understanding that intervenors are not raising issues relating to records generated in connection with Sprint originated traffic.

2. With respect to any toll traffic generated by ICG and passed through a

direct connection with Sprint, the following applies:

(a) For ICG-originated 1+ dialed toll traffic, Sprint transports the call under

its access tariff to the end-user's presubscribed interexchange carrier's POP, and the IXC

carries/terminates. This call is treated as any other IXC carried call and is not in issue in

this case. As mentioned above, the traffic is not exchanged under the interconnection

agreement.

(b) For ICG-originated 1+ dialed intraLATA toll traffic where ICG's end user

has no PIC, Sprint transports the call under its access tariff to the terminating LEC within

the LATA. Sprint creates a standard 11-01 record and provides it to any third party who

may terminate the call as long as Sprint is the originating tandem provider. Again, as

mentioned above, the traffic is not exchanged under the interconnection agreement.

3. Finally, the format of Sprint's 1101 record is consisted with the industry

standard format. However, Sprint provides a Calling Party Number ("CPN") instead of a

Carrier Identification Code ("CIC").
