On October 15, 1999, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE or Company), a division of Southern Union Company, of Kansas City, Missouri filed a tariff sheet proposed to become effective November 1, 1999. MGE filed a substitute tariff sheet on October 25, 1999, to correct an omission in the text. tariff sheet was filed to reflect scheduled changes in MGE's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors as the result of estimated changes in the cost of gas for the upcoming winter season. Additionally, this tariff filing reflects changes in the Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA), Refund, Transition Cost (TC) factors.

The net effect of these changes will increase the firm PGA factor for the 1999-2000 winter season to \$0.41724 per Ccf from a summer season firm PGA factor of \$0.34174 per Ccf. This represents an approximate 22% increase in the cost of gas to consumers.

Case No. GR-99-304, under which this PGA change was filed, was established to address MGE's PGA factors in its 1998-1999 ACA filings. Case No. GR-98-167 was established to address MGE's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 1997-98 filings. Interim subject to refund status should be maintained pending final Commission decisions in Case Nos. GR-98-167 and GR-99-304.

Because of the short time available to review the documentation supporting the ACA factor represented in this filing, the Procurement Analysis Department (PAD) has requested permission to submit its results and recommendation regarding information included in this ACA filing to the Commission on or before August 1, 2000.

The Commission's Gas Department - Tariffs/Rate Design Staff (Staff) has reviewed the filing of October 15, 1999, as substituted, on October 25, 1999 and has determined it was calculated in conformance with MGE's MO PSC Case No. GR-99-304 OFFICIAL CASE FILE MEMORANDUM PAGE 2 OF 2

Commission approved PGA Clause. Staff is of the opinion that good cause for approval of this tariff sheet on less than thirty (30) days notice is demonstrated by MGE's Commission approved PGA Clause allowing for ten (10) business days notice for PGA change filings. Therefore, Staff recommends that the following tariff sheet filed on October 15, 1999, and as substituted on October 25, 1999, be approved, interim subject to refund:
