On August 24, 2010, Four Seasons Racquet Club and Country Club Condominium Owners Association, Inc. ("Racquet Club") and Lake Region Water and Sewer Company ("Lake Region") requested an extension of the August 31, 2010 deadline for installing certain flow meters pursuant to the "Partial Non-Unanimous Stipulation Respecting Adjustments to Sewer Charges Applicable to the Racquet Club Condominium Property Owners Association, Inc." the Commission approved on April 14, 2010. The Commission's Staff, the remaining signatory did not join the request, but also did not oppose it.

On August 25, 2010, the Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel") objected to the request stating that the proposed extension provided no concrete timeframe for completion, and that it was imperative that actual wastewater flow be determined for the Racquet Club and the Country Club Hotel to prevent long-term subsidization by other customers. The Commission granted a temporary extension and opened this case to address Public Counsel's concerns.

Public Counsel and the Racquet Club have both filed explanations of their positions regarding the extension. The Commission will direct its Staff to respond.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than September 17, 2010, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall reply to the parties' pleadings in this matter and provide the Commission with a recommendation for a reasonable time frame required for the signatory parties to satisfy the terms of the "Partial Non-Unanimous Stipulation Respecting Adjustments to Sewer Charges Applicable to the Racquet Club Condominium Property Owners Association, Inc." referenced in the body of this order.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
