MISSOURI GAS ENERGY'S MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company ("MGE"), respectfully requests the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") to grant expedited approval of a tariff proposing to waive the connection and reconnection fees necessitated due to property damage incurred as a result of the recent tornadoes.

- 1. Concurrent with this Motion, MGE is filing a proposed change to its General Terms and Conditions for Gas Service, P.S.C. Mo.-No. 1, Sheet No. R-34. The proposed tariff sheet provides for waiver of any connection or reconnections charges as set forth in Section 14 of the General Terms and Conditions for Gas Service for those customers whose gas service was disconnected due to property damage incurred as a result of the recent tornadoes in Missouri.
