ORDER SETTING ON-THE-RECORD PRESENTATION

On March 7, 1997, the Commission issued an order establishing this case to develop recommendations on standardized procedures for anchoring manufactured homes. In that order, a working group was created which consisted of participants from various interest groups including the industry, regulatory agencies, and consumers. On February 13, 1998, a Majority Report was filed recommending certain standards and on March 9, 1998, a Minority Report was filed recommending different standards.

Because of the technical nature of the standards, an on-the-record presentation by the parties of the technical issues would be beneficial. Specifically, the Commission will order the working group to present an explanation to the Commission, and answer Commission questions, concerning the two recommendations including the benefits and detriments of each for maximum strap spacing and maximum strap angles, the cost to consumers of each recommendation, and the impact, if any, on insurance coverage for consumers.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Minority and the Majority of the Public Service Commission Anchor Working Group shall present to the Commission on

August 10, 1998, beginning at 9:00 a.m., a detailed explanation of their recommendations as stated above.

2. That the presentation will be held in the Commission's hearing room on the fifth floor of the Harry S Truman State Office Building, 301 West High Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.

3. 4. That this order shall become effective on July 10, 1998.
